1. Do you offer paid internships?

No. Internships are unpaid only.

- 3. How do I establish an Educational Affiliation Agreement between CVHS and my school?

Have your school contact Organizational Learning at 828.326.3576 to begin the EAA process. This process typically takes 4-6 weeks.

4. Can I participate in a "shadowing" experience to obtain hours for admission to my future program of study?

At this time, shadowing opportunities to obtain hours for program admission are not allowed. Please see question 2 for information about observation experiences.
